

Title: Common, Simple Troubleshooting (Example From Urbana)

Greetings all,

Just a quick note to share another Immanuel story from Urbana. This story provides an example of a common, simple blockage, and how it can often be identified and resolved fairly easily and quickly. (This account is from one of the troubleshooting consultants.)

“The recipient was an Asian man who could not connect to Jesus. After listening to both the facilitator and the recipient, I asked the recipient if he had any hesitancy about connecting to Jesus. He closed his eyes and pondered my question for a few moments, and then said, “Yes.” He did not want to appear before Jesus because he had done some things that were wrong. I told him that that was understandable. I then asked the recipient if he wanted to ask Jesus if He did not want to be with him because he had done some wrong things. He again closed his eyes and was quiet for a few moments, and then responded that Jesus had said He was glad to be with him even when he had done things that were wrong. At that point the session seemed to take off.”

I realize that this story is not very dramatic, but the point is that troubleshooting can often be this simple and straightforward.
