**Note from Dan Easley:**

Dear Immanuel Prayer Facilitators,

Peter Horton, with InterVarsity Christian Fellowship, has asked me to help administer an Immanuel Prayer opportunity with InterVarsity Staff. Peter is on temporary leave right now to focus on further development of Immanuel Prayer at InterVarsity. Please direct any questions to me.

InterVarsity is orienting their new staff in mid- June. Saturday, June 15, is a Sabbath day. As part of the Sabbath day they want the staff members to each be able to experience Immanuel Prayer. Here are some details about this opportunity.

- The prayer sessions will be virtual, via Zoom.
- Eight "one-hour" sessions will be provided: 2:00 PM to 10:00 PM Central Time on June 15.
- You may facilitate as few or as many sessions as you would like. The sessions you facilitate do not necessarily need to be consecutive.
- Sessions will be 45-55 minutes to allow facilitators a break between sessions.
- Staff members will sign up in advance for a specific time slot; we will know how many prayer ministers are needed for each time slot.
- As many as 130 staff may receive prayer - we are looking for many facilitators.
- We are not requiring a specific format to be followed – use whatever Immanuel Prayer format you are most comfortable with.
- We are asking that you not "push" people toward resolving traumatic memories. If traumatic memories come forward during interaction with Jesus, then that is fine and deal with it appropriately. But don't push in that direction on your own.

- Nearly all the new staff just graduated from college and are in the process of raising their support. This is Gen Z: Many struggle with social anxiety so raising support will be difficult. Their major fear is the fear of making mistakes. For any that bring up raising support, talking with Jesus about their fears would be very helpful.
- Terminology you may hear:
  - ONS = Orientation for New Staff = the name of this event.
  - MPD = Ministry Partner Development = raising support
