Maggie #2: "If I leave, she could die" (The Immanuel Approach to Emotional Healing):

In this ministry session Maggie works on fear, uncertainty, and confusion about a very tough judgment call she was forced to make regarding one of her ministry clients. After identifying the target, I coach Maggie to focus on a memory of a past positive experience with Jesus, and in the context of this positive memory we help her to refresh her perception of His presence and her connection with Him. She then engages directly with Jesus regarding the recent difficult clinical situation and her corresponding fear, uncertainty, and confusion. Jesus does a beautiful job of mentoring her with respect to the recent situation with her client, and then also brings forward a matching traumatic childhood memory that needs to be resolved. Finally, Maggie's report at the five-month follow-up interview indicates lasting fruit regarding the issues addressed in the session. This faith-building session demonstrates the principles, techniques, and process of the Immanuel approach to emotional healing. **Note: This session provides an especially good example of our current "Immanuel approach to emotional healing."**
