Maggie #3: Labor and delivery trauma (The Immanuel approach to emotional healing). Those who attended the June 2008 THRIVE conference in Springfield may remember one of the condensed sessions about a woman who was feeling overwhelmed by a particular client situation that she perceived to be stressing her beyond her strength, and feeling angry at both her husband and the Lord for being unhelpful and "hard." You may also remember that she then went to traumatic memories from her first labor and delivery (which contained the exact same thoughts and emotions), that she worked through these memories with Jesus, and that her negative thoughts and emotions towards her client, her husband, and the Lord then resolved. This is the full session from which the segments shown at the THRIVE conference were taken. This fourth set of condensed sessions includes the condensed versions of Dawn: Disarming the Lure of Affirmation (Immanuel Interventions, Basic-Intermediate), (Rita #3: Jesus is Better than Candy (Immanuel approach, basic-intermediate), Renae: Healing Helps Parenting (Immanuel approach, basic-intermediate), and Maggie #3: Labor and delivery trauma (The Immanuel approach to emotional healing). For those who have been asking us for more resources regarding the Immanuel approach to emotional healing, the full length session provides excellent examples of the process, including the initial steps of positive memory recall, deliberate appreciation, and refreshed connection with the Lord. The fourth set of condensed sessions provides an excellent resource for introducing people to the Immanuel approach. When someone asks "so what does it look like?," there's nothing like popping in a DVD with 15 to 20 minute condensed sessions where you can see the initial connection with the Lord, discovery of the traumatic memories underlying the triggered reactions in the present, work with the Lord to heal the memories, and then follow-up interviews where the person describes lasting changes since the healing session. I don't know if I can honestly say that the full length session would make good Christmas presents (too educational – a little too much like work?), but I think the fourth set of condensed sessions would make a fine gift. Even if you're not studying emotional healing, these

condensed sessions are engaging, inspirational, and faith building. I have gone through them many, many times during the editing process and I still enjoy watching them – I love seeing the Living Jesus heal people *live, right on camera*.
