Really a wonderful gift to this woman...she was able to speak out loud a recent trauma her whole family experienced. Jesus met her powerfully, reassuring her that He will be with her even when she doubts. Her tender heart received His comfort and care in tangible ways. So sweet to witness. It was such a helpful session for the whole room, giving opportunity for deeper coaching and instructing.

Immanuel Prayer is gaining traction here in Kampala, Uganda! These men and women are wanting to continue practicing, learning and growing. They are making concrete plans to carry it forward. Amazing.

I connected today to the fact that my first two visits to Uganda were the catalyst for my learning IP...God has used this country, these people, to introduce me to Immanuel. I am deeply grateful for this gift and for coming full circle to bring it back here in this way. IP has changed how I relate to Jesus, how I do counseling and how I minister to others. I am a different person because of meeting Jesus more deeply in IP. Wow."
