A colleague and long time friend, Julia Pferdehirt, who works with a ministry called Because Justice Matters in San Francisco, just sent us the following note that I thought might be both encouraging and helpful to those of you who are working in similar situations:

"We use Immanuel Prayer ALL the time. Sometimes, the women we know on the streets are very limited in their capacity. Mental illness and addiction have taken great tolls on their minds and bodies. So, a woman may only be able to remain engaged for a limited time. Yet, we find if we simply ask, "Is it okay to ask Jesus about this?" And then ask, "Jesus would you show (NAME) where you are right now?" And, "Jesus what do you want (NAME) to know?" -- If we are only able to engage with her for that long, STILL, powerful, powerful exchanges happen between women and Jesus! God comes and speaks. Women sense and see Him and are comforted. This has been such a help for us - from the smallest Immanuel moment to the largest."
