Greetings all,

Just a quick note, in case you're doing your year-end accounting and trying to discern the Lord's guidance with respect to stewardship.

The good news is that the contributions that have already come in will fully cover the first wave of Immanuel Approach training for InterVarsity. (THANK YOU!) We have been working with a cohort of 29 staff and leaders throughout the fall, and have already completed a series of zoom training sessions that included explanation of the theory, demonstrations, and practice exercises. We were able to go through each component of the Immanuel Approach process, and then we put all of the pieces together for two variations of the full IA process for healing traumatic memories. This has all gone very well, and the InterVarsity leadership people working most closely with me continue to be very positive.

Furthermore, the first wave of training will also include two mentoring groups that I have put together specifically for any from this first cohort of staff and ministry leaders who are able to participate. (These groups will run through Winter and Spring of 2021).

More good news is that this first wave of training is going so well that InverVarsity would like to go forward with a second wave – essentially the same package -- for a second cohort of staff and ministry leaders. The hope is to end up with thirty to fifty strategic staff and ministry leaders who can then help Immanuel Approach principles and techniques spread throughout the rest of InterVarsity.

So at this point we are welcoming contributions for the second wave of training. And thank you again to those of you have already helped support the first wave of this adventure, and thank you in advance to those of you who decided to help with the second wave of training.

Throughout this next year, may you and your family be more and more able to perceive Jesus' living, tangible, interactive, wonderful, loving, healing, wise, strong, gentle, life-giving, always-relational, friendship presence walking beside you and abiding with you each day! (This is my Christmas and New Years Immanuel blessing. 😊)
