

Title: Is Immanuel Approach Coaching/Facilitating Really Necessary? -- Video

Greetings all,

People sometimes ask, “Why do we need to do all of this complicated Immanuel Approach facilitating? God doesn’t need our help! We should be able to just pray, ‘Lord, You will be done,’ or ‘Jesus, please come and heal this person.’ I don’t think any of this additional complexity is necessary.”

This is an understandable question, and I have just posted another teaching nugget to address it. The short summary is that I think Immanuel Approach coaching/facilitating is a form of co-laboring with Christ. Just as God asks us to go forth and share the Gospel as a form of co-laboring with Christ (as opposed to just sitting at home and praying, “God, save everybody in the world), I think that coaching/facilitating the Immanuel Approach is a form of co-laboring with Christ.

This teaching is now posted as another one of the “Teaching Nuggets” at the bottom of the “Resources” page of www.immanuelapproach.com. NOTE: the “Teaching Nuggets” section does not show up on the drop down menu when you click on “Resources” from the menu bar at the top of the Home page. You have to actually **go to the Resources page**, and then scroll to the very bottom of the page. (Note: on some devices, the nuggets at the bottom will be out of view when the first screen opens – you have to scroll “below the fold” – that is, beneath the content initially visible.) Also, it’s one of the clips in the video window, as opposed to one of the essays.
