Here's yet another encouraging, inspiring note from an InterVarsity alumna:

"As an Intervarsity alumna, former I.V.C.F. staffworker, and committed practitioner and trainer of Immanuel Approach, I have renewed hope for the world as I envision the impact of I.V.C.F. staff and students receiving this unencumbered way of being intimate with Jesus.

While staffing a previous Urbana, I attended a workshop on prayer followed by prayer ministry by one of the workshop prayer ministers. I experienced what Immanuel Approach/Dr. Lehman would call a "living, interactive, contingent and beneficial" encounter with Jesus. It changed my thoughts and behaviors that day. I remember it vividly, and the powerful positive impact of the experience still influences me now, many years later.

In the days and years that followed, I sought after that same experience at staff training and conferences, and sometimes well-intentioned people offered prayer ministry with the tools they had. Sometimes I felt alienated, mis-attuned and far from Jesus and confused. This sacred wound set me on a lifetime quest to learn prayer for myself and others that is relationally safe, and legitimately led by Jesus. Life, ministry, and strategies all became clear, focused and simple once I began practicing Immanuel Approach in 2015. Every day I experience, and help others experience, living, interactive, contingent and beneficial encounters with Jesus. I am thoroughly convinced IV staff and students will experience this too."
